1. IDENTIFICATION / NOTIFICATION

A local church or institution becomes aware of a POC/PSOA and notifies AdSAFE

2a. INTERIM MEASURES

The POC/PSOA is placed on an Interim Fellowship Agreement (FA) for **One year**

3. DECISION TO PROCEED

This process is to assess the local church's capacity to implment an Individualised FA.

This occurs through meetings with:

The local pastor and the POC/PSOA

The local church board

Acountability group / network

The General Secretary

2b. ALTERNATIVE WORSHIP ARRANGEMENTS

If the POC/PSOA does not agree to the Interim FA, they are not permitted to attend the SDA Church.

The POC/PSOA will still receive pastoral support and fellowship within their own home.



4. ASSESSMENT FOR INDIVIDUALISED FELLOWSHIP AGREEMENT

After a period of 1 year the POC/PSOA is transitioned onto an Individualised FA.

A Forensic Risk Assessment is required for medium to high priorotiy response POC/PSOAs. This assessment will guide the terms of the Agreement.

If the POC/PSOAs is deemed a low priority response an Individualised FA can be offered that refelcts potential situational factors.

5. ESTABLISH / IMPLIMENT INDIVIDUALISED SAFETY AGREEMENT

Where required, AdSAFE is to train the local pastor and accountability group / network.



6. ONGOING SUPPORT AND REVIEW

Quarterly compliance schedules

12 month reviews through phone meetings between POC/PSOA, local Pastor and AdSAFE Case Officers
