Local Church Board

The **local church** has a spiritual, ethical and legal responsibility to protect children and vulnerable adults in its faith community.

The first National Child-safe Standard highlights the importance of child safety being imbedded in organizational leadership, governance and culture.

The **Church Board** is the local church governance body. The Board takes a key role in decisionmaking to ensure that a safe environment is built and maintained.

The Board should take the following steps to create a safe environment for everyone:

- **1** Board members should comply with the Adsafe pre-requisites:
 - Adsafe Safer Churches Awareness Training
 - Adsafe Code of Conduct
 - Working With Children Check (or equivalent) clearance
- 2. Approve and implement the Adsafe Child & Vulnerable Persons Protection Policy.
- 3. Approve and implement the Adsafe Role Requirements Guidelines.
- 4. Record the appointment of the Adsafe Responsible Officer and the Adsafe Compliance Assistant.
- 5. Submit Form A to Adsafe with the details of action taken in relation to points 2 4 above.
- 6. Approve which roles in their local church are classified as child-related and complete Schedule B.
- 7. Design contingency plans for when non-compliant church officers are stood down.
- 8. Place child safety as a standing agenda item at Board meetings such that the church can monitor its progress and discuss relevant matters.
- 9. Design and implement a procedurally fair process to handle complaints.
- **10.** Be aware of the process for handling allegations of abuse and harm.
